

Transcatheter uterine artery embolization proved to be a highly effective technique for controlling acute and chronic genital bleeding in a wide variety of obstetric and gynecologic disorders.

This alternative approach enables ease of bleeder detection, avoidance of surgical risks, fertility preservations and shorter hospitalizations.
