ABSTRACT

The study aimed to assess the pregnant women health needs and demands in prison. The research questions, what are the pregnant women's health needs in prisons?, what are the pregnant women's demands in prisons? And what are the factor affecting the health of pregnant prisoners. The study **conducted** at ELkanater and Damanhur prison, the researcher applies purposive sample technique. The study involved all pregnant prisoners agreed to participate in the study. The tools used for data collection involved structured interview questionnaire to collect personal and demographic data, present and past history regard pregnancy and social health needs, services provided in prison and factors that affect pregnant women health. The result of the present study revealed that the most studied sample obtain good antenatal care in prison such as follow up with ultrasound(93.1%) while there were &psychological support to them. The studied sample face many factors affect health of them, include imprisonment itself, shortage of nurses & poor social support, but there were proper sanitation & no work to pregnant women in prison according prison policy, finally the present study Concluded that The majority of the sample obtain good antenatal care as follow up with ultrasound but other hand the pregnant prisoners suffered from poor social &psychological care and also limited cope with minor discomfort, so the researcher Recommend that should enhance Proper training of health care providers in prison about how to deal with problem facing pregnant women in prison& Public health services must provide medical and psychological services convoys to pregnant prisoners.
