Anorexia

Loss of appetite

Dysuria

Burning of urination

Erythema

Redness of the skin

Epistaxis

Bleeding from nose.

Extravasation

Leaking of I.v fluids out of the vein

Hepatosplenomegaly

Enlargement of liver and spleen

Macule:
