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
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
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ABSTRACT

The aim of this study was to develop an instrument to assess clinical practice of Technical Nursing Institute student in adult nursing course. The development of the instrument passed through several steps. The validity of the instrument is measured through content validity and construct validity. Reliability of the instrument has been tested by cronbach's coefficient alpha. Reliability of the teachers is assessed through interrater reliability. It is concluded that the developed instrument is highly reliable in the measuring of student's performance in all dimensions of clinical performance.



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
