Abstract of Thesis

This Thesis studies and publishes religious spells written on the lids of the wooden coffins of *Wsir P3* ^{cc}ny. The cult of the deity Wsir *P3* ^{cc}ny and his role in Tuna el-Gebel Necropolis as well. The study was divided into an introduction, a preface, and four chapters. Results of this study will be given in the conclusion. A palaeographical study is done at the end of the work.

Introduction;

It contains the reasons for choosing the subject of the study, its objectives, and previous studies, difficulties encountered by the researcher, research methodology and finally brief information on the worship of animals.

Preface;

It includes historical overview of the site of Tuna el-Gebel, then it covers the types of coffins of Wsir P3 ^{cc}ny and the types of texts inscribed on them.
