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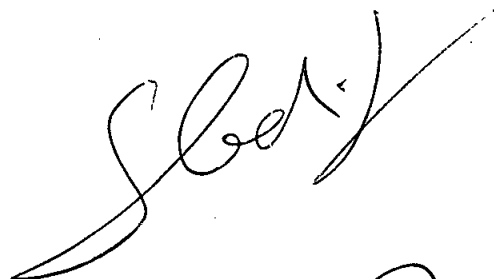
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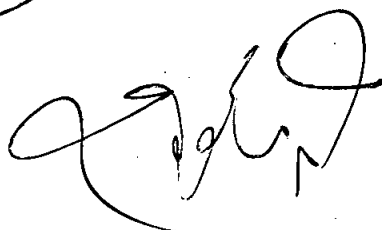
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Advancement in Laparoscopic Surgery

- Laparoscopic cholecystectomy has gained a world-wide acceptance over the last Five years since its introduction.

There are several reasons for the unprecedented popularity of laparoscopic cholecystectomy, including cosmetic appeal, small incision, shortened hospital stay, reduced convalescence, lower costs, and less pain.
