Permissive parenting:-

Gentle and indulgent when their children make mistakes and they forgive them easily.

Uninvolved parenting:

Display a lack of demands, support and encouragement towards their children.

Behaviors:

Behaviors refers to the actions of a living being or a system in response to various external impulsions.

Behavioral problems:

Behavioral problems include problems related to repeated violation of other's rights, aggressiveness, hyperkinetic impulsive behavior, and missing classes or running away from school.

Lying:

Lying :making a false statement with the intention to deceive.
