## Women's reaction regarding different types of Harassment

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### Abstract

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**The study aimed** to assess women's reaction regarding different types of harassment **Design:** Descriptive design was used. **Setting:** the main health center of 10<sup>th</sup> Ramadan city. **Sample:** purposive sample was used. **Tools:** **Tool 1:** a structured interviewing questionnaire sheet. **Tool II: Likert scale;** to assess woman's reaction regarding harassment. **Results:**, more than two fifth of the studied women there age ranged between 20>30years old and was had secondary education, As regard total reaction majority of the studied women had negative reaction regarding harassment Also, there was positive correlation between total knowledge of the studied women and their total reactions regarding harassment, also there was statistical significant relation between occupation & household income and studied women reaction regarding harassment. **Conclusion:** one third of the studied women there reaction during harassment was anger and distress using facial features and more than one half of this reaction after harassment was selfdepression. There was no statistical significant relation between harassment &types of harassment and women reaction. **Recommendation:** Increase health education through mass media about harassment knowledge, attitude and practices and methods of protection. **Further studies should stress investigating the:** Effect of harassment on Women's quality of life. 2- Study of the factors associated with harassment among women

## **Operational Definition**

**Reaction:** defined as response of women to some situation or stimulus her reaction or bodily response (*Neupane, 2017*).

**Harassment:** definition of harassment is unwanted conduct on the grounds of race, gender, sexual orientation etc. which has the purpose or effect of either violating the women dignity, or creating an fear, hostile, degrading, humiliating or offensive environment for them (*Canadian human rights commission, 2018*).

## Introduction

The standard definition for harassment is unwanted conduct on the grounds of race, gender, sexual orientation etc. which has the purpose or effect of either violating the women dignity, or creating an fear, hostile, degrading, humiliating or offensive environment for them (*Canadian Human Rights Commission, 2018*).

Reaction defined as the reacting women against a force, influence, or movement, and can be defined as response women to some situation or stimulus her reaction or bodily response, Also defined as a mental or emotional responded to women's life situation and the force that a body subjected to the action of a force from another body exerts (*Neupane, 2017*).

Reactions to harassment is some-times not allowed because this go back to the culture of our society as it concenter stigma for woman, so that the proportion of women who report harassment is very low, the women's reaction immediately after the occurrence of harassment vary from woman to another (*Neupane, 2017*).
